By becoming a member of the Fourth Degree you are providing a positive expression of service to our Order and a true testament of allegiance to your faith, church, community, and our country.

This letter will provide you, your family, and guests, with the needed information about this very important day.

You are required to wear a standard dark suit or sport coat, dark dress pants (Black, Dark Blue or Gray) collared white shirt, dark tie, black socks and black dress shoes. If you served in the Armed Forces or are a full time Police Officer or Firefighter, you may dress in your Class A dress uniform in lieu of wearing a suit. You will need to fill out the Fourth Degree Form-4 (see your Financial Secretary for the form). Complete your portion and return it to the Financial Secretary with the Application fee payable to District Master of Maine. The Financial Secretary will complete his portion and will forward the form and fee to the Assembly you are joining. After completion of the Assembly portion the Faithful Comptroller will forward the application and monies to Executive Secretary Dan LaLonde at his address listed below.

Registration will begin May 4th, 2019 at **10:30 AM** at Christ Church (Kitchen Entrance) located by the parking lot to the right of the Kennebunk Town Hall located on 1 Summer St. Kennebunk. Please arrive **NO LATER THAN 11:00AM**. Lunch will be provided to you following your registration. The degree starts at **12:00 Noon**.

A group photo of the candidates will be taken immediately following the degree exemplification.

The ladies function will consist of a tour of the Franciscan Monastery and gift shop followed by shopping in Kennebunkport village. Bus transportation will be provided. Pick up will be 11:30AM at

St. Martha's front parking lot located on 30 Portland Rd. Kennebunk and will return by 3:15 PM so as to give enough time to drive to St. Mary's church located at 236 Eldridge Rd. Wells for 4 PM mass, Knighting Ceremony and subsequent banquet. The banquet will be held following the 4 PM Mass in the attached hall.

Candidate banquet ticket is included in the \$70.00 application fee and will be given to you at the registration table which will be located at the Christ Church kitchen entrance. Extra banquet tickets for family or guests are available at a cost of \$35.00 each, also picked up at the registration table. No tickets will be mailed out.
